SLAVEOWNERS OF FREDERICK COUNTY AND WINCHESTER IN 1860.

An alphabetical listing of all the slaveowners of Frederick County and the City of Winchester in the year 1860 has been prepared from microfilm of the original Schedule No. 2, U.S. Census, enumerated by J. W. Pifer, June-October, 1860. This special census lists the owners and employers of slaves, the number of slaves owned or rented by each, the sex and age of the slaves and the number of slave quarters. It was felt that the compilation and indexing of this census would be of some genealogical and historical value to researchers as well as of general interest to the families involved. It affords a fascinating glimpse of this aspect of life in Winchester and Frederick County just prior to the War Between the States. No political or racial biases are intended in the report.

Although the task of copying and indexing was time-consuming, the project is not, nor is it intended to be, original or creative. It simply reports the information contained in this census. The census enumerator could have made errors of spelling and of omission or insertion. Generally the writing was clear and unmistakable. Whenever it was not, an attempt was made to cross-check the names and information given in Schedule No. 2 with Schedule No. 1, Regular U.S. Census of 1860.

Slaveowners and employers are listed in alphabetical order (The term 'employer' refers to those people who rented slaves from others as differentiated from actual owners). In cases where the employer is listed, the name of the actual owner is given as well as the county where he resided. The page number on which each owner or employer is listed in the census is provided as well as the Magisterial District in which he or she resided. The total number of slaves owned or rented was tabulated. Further information relative to the sex and slave quarters can be elicited from the microfilm copy.

Conclusions Based on this tabulation.

According to the Special Census, there were 2,258 slaves in Winchester and Frederick County just a few months prior to the outbreak of the War Between the States. There were 1,097 male slaves and 1,162 female slaves.

There were 405 slaveowners or employers in Frederick County and Winchester. Of these, 104 were women owners or employers and 301 were men.

The total population of Winchester and Frederick County in 1860 was 20,938; slaveowners therefore represented about 2% of the total population, with an average ownership of five slaves each.

Frederick Co., 1860 Slave Owners

There were eight magisterial districts in Frederick County in 180. The City of Winchester (W) and the town of Stephensburg (Stephens City) (S) were enumerated separately. Although there is no clear-cut definition of the boundaries of the eight districts, a general location for each is listed below:

Districts No. 1, 2, and 3 were centered around the city of Winchester--north, south and east.

District No. 4 encompassed the Clear Brook - Stephenson - White Hall - Apple Pie Ridge - Pughtown (Gainesboro) Pike area.

District No. 5 was in the Gainesboro area.

District No. 6 was in the Core and Back Creek Valley area.

District No. 7 included the Mt. Falls and Marlboro sections.

District No. 8 was in the Middletown and Stephens City sections.

The current magisterial districts were not created until 1870.

Familiarity with the names of the people and families and research in the various historical and biographical studies pertaining to this area will help those who desire to locate the precise place in which these people resided.

The districts containing the largest number of slaveowners and slaves were the City of Winchester and Districts 4 and 8. The largest slaveholding families, those owning twenty or more slaves, were: Abbott, Barton, Boyd, Burwell, Byrd, Carson, Carter, Chamberlain, Clevenger, Fragier, Glass, Hamalton, Harrison, Hitè, Hollingsworth, Jones, Massie, Owens, Powell, SeEVERS, Silvers, Smith, Stephenson, Timberlake, Washington, and Woods.

GENERAL EDITORS' NOTES.

The yeoman task performed by the author initiates a new undertaking in providing a series of accurate, computer-analyzed and sorted data for Virginia censuses. Using the transcribed census records, a computer file was constructed, along with an index listing not only the surname of the household head, but also all those surnames of persons listed as 'Living in Household' and heretofore unreachable in previous indices. This is an important feature in itself, for 1,850 persons with surnames other than that of the household enumerated were included in this census, and therefore current indices which list only household surnames miss almost one person in seven on the census roll. The back of this current work lists all surnames, along with the district abbreviation and the household number for quick, ready reference (See pages 321-358).

The census taker walking from household to household in the summer and fall of 1850 had scant comprehension of the vital social document he was constructing. While the enumeration of the population was an important task and the results were quickly discernible, such as the number of people living within each district of the county, there were also numerous patterns and statistics buried within the census enumerator's listings which the modern computer can readily discern. While it might be of marginal value to know that in Frederick County in 1850, there was one professional ventriloquist, or that thirty-five children were listed as being eight months old at the time of the census, or that one person valued his real estate property at \$518.00, still the computer analysis of this census elucidates some more important social trends of the time.

A quick check revealed 13,613 persons listed in the census for Frederick County and its communities (this does not include another 2,294 slaves who were not on the census rolls). Of this population, 23% was black or mulatto (The number of free blacks constituted about 7%).

It has always been mentioned by genealogists and historians that Frederick County stood at an important crossroads in the road west across the Appalachians. Winchester was the departure point for many immigrants from Virginia, Pennsylvania, and Maryland. The following list derived from the census data shows that 924 persons listed their birthplaces as other than Virginia, and of that number, 608 were born in either Pennsylvania or Maryland. The remainder were scattered among thirty states, territories and countries.

Another set of interesting figures were extracted from the real estate valuations placed by the property owners. Of the 946 who responded to this question, 404 or 42% valued their property under \$1,000.00, with the lowest valuation set at \$45.00. At the other end of the scale, 104 or 11% set their property valuations at \$10,000 - 39,999, and 15 persons placed their holdings in excess of \$40,000 (The highest valuation was that of James Marshall, son of former Chief Justice John Marshall; James's property was valued at \$138,700, quite a fortune for that time). The average property value of those reporting was \$8,282.00

Age and household distribution figures lend themselves to analysis through modern sorting routines. Ages in the county

ranged from newborn of less than a month to two centenarians, aged 102 and 108 respectively. The average age of every person in the county was 23 years, 2 months. Distribution of household sizes reveals the continuing trend toward large families and extended households as opposed to more modern nuclear family units. Not counting the 1,850 individuals listed as 'Living in Household', some of whom must have been relatives while others were merely visiting or living as laborers and servants, the average family unit size in 1850 in Frederick County was almost exactly 5 persons per household. With the 'L.I.H.' individuals included, this figure rises to 5.8 persons. These figures are reflected below in the table which delineates the size distribution of all households as well as black households.

Finally, occupations are an important indicator of the importance and nature of the county's development. With the major city of Winchester, the variety of occupations below comes as no surprise. What is interesting, however, is the frequency of some of these occupations. Saddlers (22) were only slightly less important than lawyers (25) in the life of Frederick County, while eighteen tavern keepers kept the county's roadside inns and town establishments. Two early 'Daguerrians' who produced photographs were in Frederick, along with one 'fancy painter.' The list is reproduced below in its entirety for the reader's examination.
